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



Plural nouns name more than one person, place, or thing.

- Add -s to form the plural of most nouns.
 picture/pictures wing/wings pattern/patterns
- Add -es to nouns ending in ch, sh, x, z, s, and ss.
 bunch/bunches wish/wishes box/boxes class/classes
- If a noun ends in a vowel and y, add -s. day/days boy/boys
- If a noun ends in a consonant and y, change y to i and add -es.
 city/cities lady/ladies
- Some nouns have irregular plural forms. They change spelling.
 man/men mouse/mice goose/geese foot/feet child/children
- For most nouns that end in f or fe, change f to v and add -es. leaf/leaves knife/knives calf/calves
- Some nouns have the same singular and plural forms.

VCe syllables are syllables that contain a vowel, consonant, and the letter e. When the VCe syllable appears at the end of a word, usually the first vowel has a long vowel sound, and the e is silent.

VCe syllables can appear at the end of multisyllabic words. In most cases, the first vowel sound is long, and the e at the end is silent. For example, in the word remote, the VCe syllable pattern is ote. The o is long and the e is silent.

Regular and Irregular Plural Nouns

Plural Nouns name more than one person, place, thing, or idea. Sometimes spelling changes are necessary before making a word plural.

- Regular plurals are formed by adding -s or -es. Sometimes spelling changes are necessary before adding -es.
- Irregular plurals do not end in -s or -es. Some irregular nouns are made plural by changing their spelling. Others have the same singular and plural form. You must memorize the plural forms or use a dictionary to help.

vowel + y	add -s	sprays, trolleys, boys
