STATION 1 – Physical Exam

- Walk back and forth for 30 seconds.
- Jog in place for one minute.
- Jump as high as you can ten times.
- Describe “Stairs of Separation/6 second test”.

STATION 2 – Health Exam

- Diseases (1/10) – Do you have any?
- Eyes (buttonhook) – Trachoma check
- Ears – infected?
- Teeth – rotten/missing?
- Head –lice?
- Heart (stethoscope) – defects?

STATION 3 – Mental Exam

- Draw a sequence of diamonds
- Answer the following basic questions
 - What is your full name? - TRANSLATE
 - What is your sex?
 - What is your age? - TRANSLATE
 - Are you married?
 - Where are you from? - TRANSLATE

STATION 4 – Education and Occupation Exam

- Schooling – How much have you had?
- Skills – Which ones do you possess?
- Work samples - **MUST PROVIDE!**
- Prospective job – What do you hope to do?

STATION 5 – Communication Exam

- Read English from a book (struggle).
- Write English – **TRANSLATE!**
- Speak English – **TRANSLATE** four statements.

STATION 6 – Legal Exam

- Show Passport
- Show money – amount in American dollars?
- Ever been here?
- Who paid for your passage?
- Family/friend connection?
- What other family members are you traveling with?
- Where are you headed?
- Ticket – pin to clothes with destination showing.

If you've received all P's, **WELCOME TO AMERICA!**
SIGN THE WALL OF IMMIGRANTS!

If you've received an X you may be **DETAINED**. You'll then be sent to the hospital or dormitories. You may eat in the cafeteria until you're paperwork and/or illnesses are cleared up. If they are not, you will be **DEPORTED!** If that's the case, better luck next time.
