



Compare and Contrast

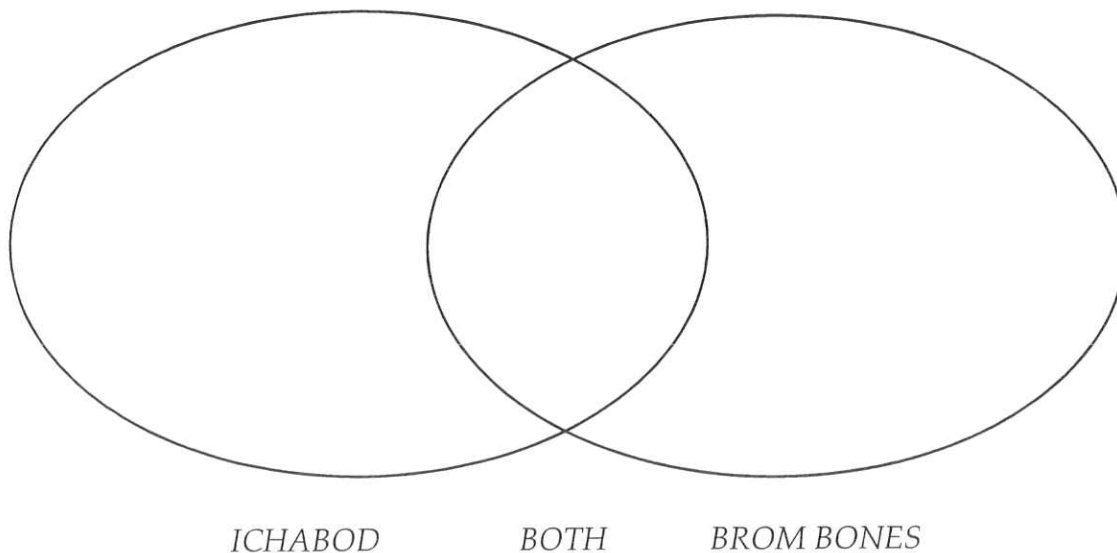
