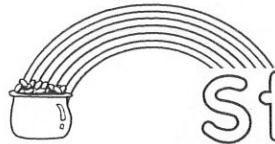

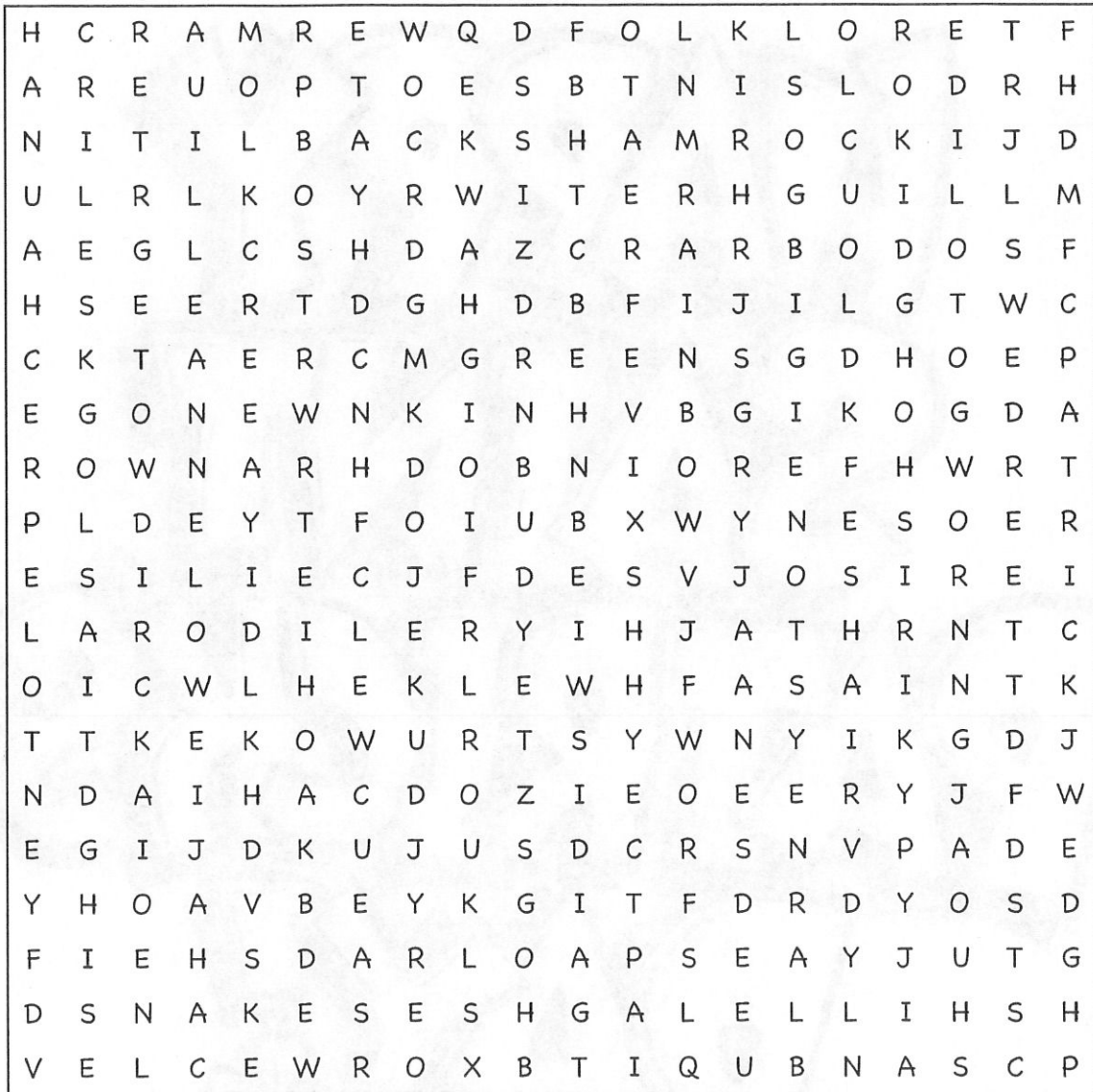

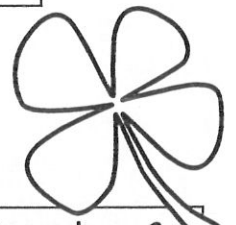

Bodhran is an Irish drum made out of wood with goat skin stretched across the top.



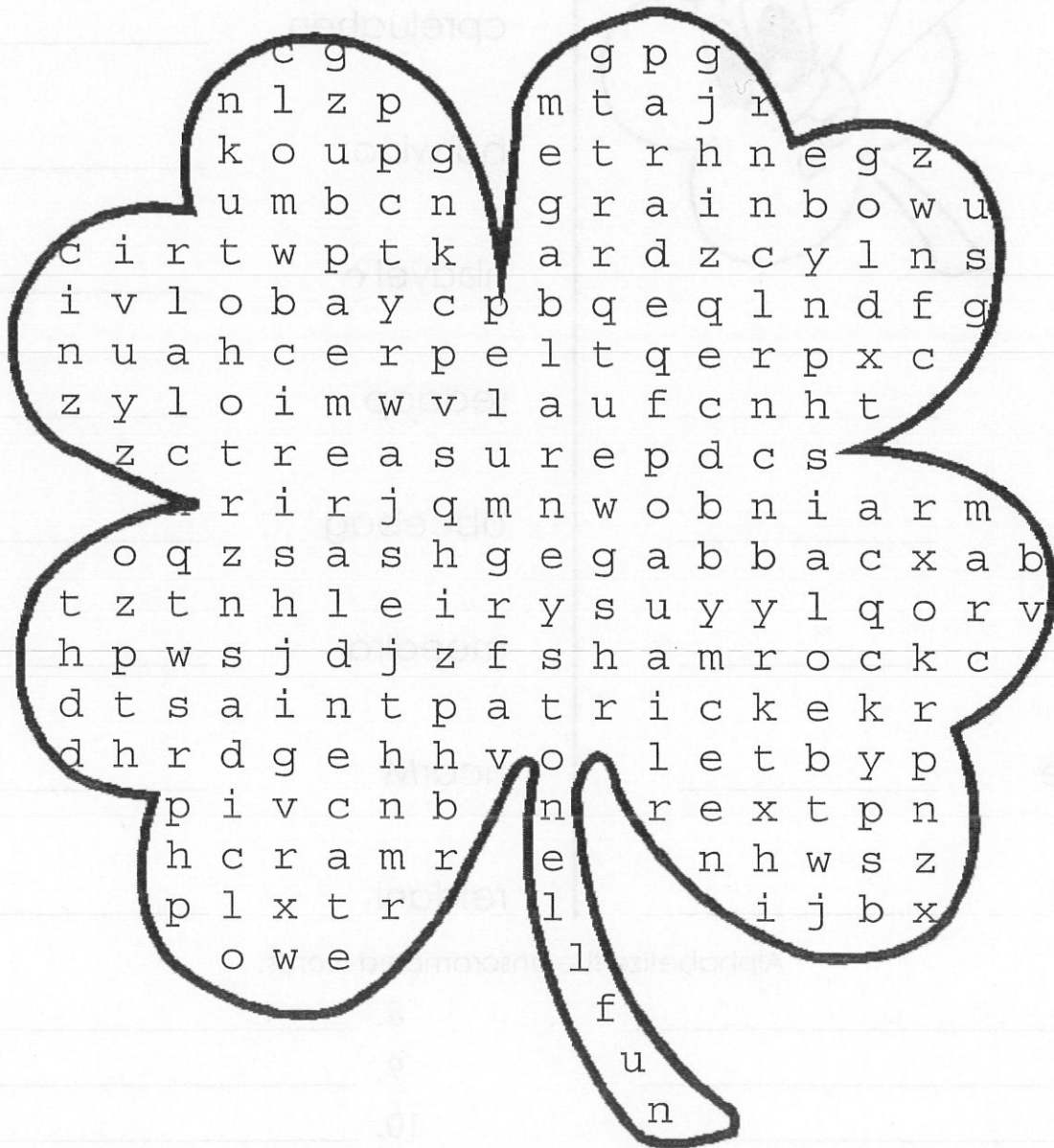

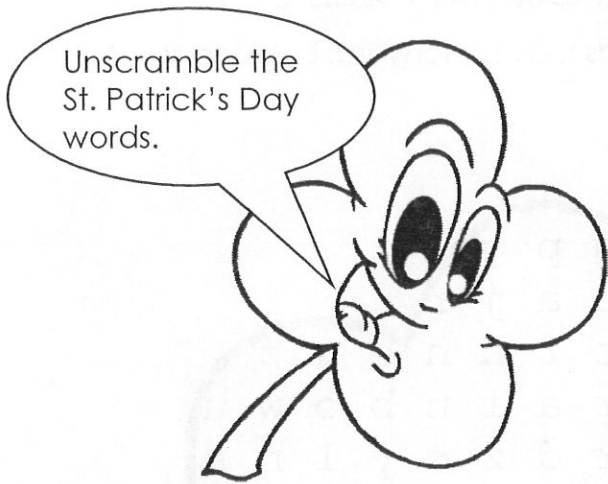
